Gold Star Post #1365 Minutes of December 14th 2024

The meeting was called to order at 10:09 by Commander Frank Saladis, the roll call was taken and noted. A motion by Paul Dietrich to accept the minutes of the November meeting as read with the correction of the Marine Corp birthday to November 10th was seconded and passed. New member Richard Muszel has transferred in from Brooklyn Post 27. Treasurer Paul Dietrich gave the post financial report and stated that the bill for the post survey was still outstanding. Commander Saladis gave an update of the post survey that was last done in 1998. The fence bordering the post's property is approximately 40' behind the actual property line resulting in the flag fire pit partially over the property line as well as several other items. The results of the survey will be turned over to the post's lawyer for action. Commander Saladis reported on the process for incorporating the post, the process is public information. Membership: the post membership now stands at 231 renewed and all renewals are due by December 31st. Michael Marra reported the SAL now stands at 70 members. House report: Mark Kelly reported that the rear door repairs have not begun and due to the amount of work involved the suggestion was made to get quotes from qualified construction companies. Children & Youth: Commander Saladis reported the tree lighting on December 12th was very successful with a full house. Thanks to Harold Bregman for reciting the meaning of Chanukah and the magician for his performance. The total cost for the evening was \$458 but thanks to the donations the final cost to the Post was \$93. The Post Auxiliary has 3 new members. Paul Dietrich reminds the members to have a copy of their DD214 on file at the post and that the social security number should be blanked out. Paul stated that the DD214 is needed for veteran's tax exemptions and other benefits. Buddy Checks; now is the time to call your buddies and check on their wellbeing and to see if they need anything. Mike Marra emphasized the need for buddy check by reporting on two veterans he had met that were contemplating suicide and thankfully received the needed help. Americanism: The annual Pearl Harbor service on December 7th chaired by County Commander Mark Kelly was extremely well attended and done well. National Security: there is an alarming number of drone sightings in the NY NJ area and the US government should be doing more about it. Media and Communications: Commander Saladis reached out to National with photos from the December 7th service. Good of the Legion; the post received a defibrillator and several members have been trained on its use. Paul Dietrich reported on the visits to the local nursing homes and the gift distribution to the veterans who were very appreciative. New business; Paul Dietrich made a motion to donate \$100 in gift cards to the food pantry for the active-duty service members, the motion was seconded and passed. Frank LaMarsh made a motion to donate \$100 to the campaign to elect John Mega Department Commander, the motion was seconded and passed. A motion by Mark Kelly to send the commander to the Four Chaplains brunch on February 8th as the Post's representative was seconded and passed. The Post is running a Super Bowl fundraiser. The Post's Wi-Fi issue was looked at by the communications company and they suggested we upgrade to commercial grade equipment that could cost approximately \$1,000. A decision was tabled until next month. Commander asked for a motion to have the Post become incorporated. A motion to do so was made by Paul Dietrich was seconded and passed. A motion by Mark Kelly to accept the transfer of the real property at 17 Cannon Avenue by the Gold Star Holding Company inc. was seconded and passed. Joe Nassella made a \$50 donation to the post. The meeting was adjourned at 11:50 by commander Saladis.
