The meeting was called to order at 10:10 by Commander Frank Saladis. Salute to the flag. Opening prayer, POW/MIA Chair placed. The roll call of officers was taken and noted. A motion by Bob Motisi to accept the minutes of the January meeting as printed in the Post newsletter was seconded by Paul Cempa and passed. New member introduced- Jerry, Navy Vet, 66-68, Reserves till 1975, Newport RI-Machinery Mate. Due to the 4 Chaplains Brunch, Commander F. Saladis made a motion to expedite the meeting agenda for a hard stop at 11am.1st -Kelly, 2nd -Motisi. Motion passed. Finance /Treasurer report: Paul Dietrich submitted a full financial excel spread sheet report prior to the meeting. The report indicated that all outstanding bills have been paid and the Post is currently in good financial condition. The report is on file in Post records. It was mentioned that the Post depends on Hall rentals for much of its revenue. Revenue generation includes fundraising events and donations. Membership: Post Renewal of Membership is a 90.3%.
